Preschool Detailed Daily Schedule

6:30 – 7:00 Playhouse Opens/Free Choice Play

Children and families will sign-in and wash hands in the lobby. Families will be greeted as they arrive, parents will assist child in getting belongings put away say goodbyes for the day. Your child will then choose from lots of fun activities like: Dress-up, kitchen play, table toys & manipulatives, blocks, cars, trains, LEGOs, coloring, painting, crafts, science exploration or experiments, music, etc. The options are endless and ever changing. There is always something fun and creative to do.

7:00 – 7:45 Breakfast

We always wash up before eating. Your child will enjoy provided healthy and nutritious breakfast or you can send your own. Monthly meal menus are posted on parent board, website, and take home copies are available on resource wall. We also encourage age appropriate eating habits, behavior and independence. When ready your child will serve his/her own meal, pour drinks, etc. We are always polite saying "please", "thank you" and "excuse me", use appropriate manners and only eat while sitting.

7:45 – 8:15 Free Choice Play

Your child will get to choose from lots of fun activities like: Dress-up, kitchen play, table toys & manipulatives, blocks, cars, trains, LEGOs, coloring, painting, crafts, science exploration or experiments, music, etc. The options are endless and ever changing. There is always something fun and creative to do.

8:15 – 8:45 Story Time

Every week and month your child will enjoy themes that our activities are centered around. We start with some theme related reading and always read some favorites. Sometimes we read huge books, sometimes tiny books, sometimes we just make something up, tell our own stories, read read-a-longs, read in groups, or one to one. Children love hearing and seeing our felt board stories. You can read to the class anytime too!

8:45 – 9:00 Bathroom Time

Children use the bathroom as necessary throughout the day and always wash their hands. "GO Potty, flush the toilet, wash your hands".

9:00 – 9:30 Circle Time

Your child will recite the Pledge of Allegiance, sing some songs, discuss the theme of the week, learn basic Spanish words, phonics, learn about the calendar, days of the week, the weather, seasons, count, sing the ABC's, do finger plays, poems, learn who is present and absent, discuss the daily schedule, talk about special happenings in their lives etc. It is a fun interactive time where your child will develop social/emotional skills as well as cognitive and language development.

9:30 – 9:45 Snack

We always wash up before eating. Your child will enjoy provided healthy and nutritious snacks or you can send your own. We also encourage age appropriate eating habits, behavior and independence. When ready your child will prepare his/her own snacks, pour drinks, etc. We are always polite saying "Please", "thank you" and "excuse me", use appropriate manners and only eat while sitting.

9:45 – 10:45 Academic Activities

Your child will have exposure to these academic activities: Reading-Readiness (colors, shapes, letters, sequencing stories, sight words, etc.), Math-Readiness (counting, sorting, sequencing, matching, etc.), writing skills (tracing and writing name, letters and numbers, journal entries, etc.), Phonics (dog starts with a ..., A is for apple, A sounds like..., how does this letter sound?, etc.), Language Arts (over/under, big/small, sequencing stories, matching, shapes, etc.)

10:45 – 11:00 Bathroom Time

11:00 – 11:30 Outdoor Play (Group A)

Your child will get a good rest and be ready for the rest of the day. If your child does not fall asleep in the first 30-45 minutes we will set her/him up with some quiet activities.
